She served on the Cambridge Arts Council Public Art Commission from 2004 - 2007 and is currently on the Advisory Board for North Cambridge Arts (NoCa) and Joy Street Artists Open Studios in Somerville, MA. Her work is in public and private collections throughout the US and abroad.
